All drivers must hold a current Clubsport or higher licence.

Drivers are responsible for all passengers to sign the indemnity form at the start line.

Any passengers under 18 years of age must complete a passenger indemnity form at Documentation signed by a parent or guardian.

All drivers must wear approved overalls and helmets.

DUAL DRIVERS will be allowed at the discretion of the Organising Committee and under instruction of the Clerk of Course.

EVENT PROGRAMME

Drivers Briefing – 11.00 am at Control at the venue.

A Reconnaissance Run/untimed practise run will be held at 11.30am this will be confirmed at Drivers Briefing.

Time, entry numbers and weather permitting – there will be a minimum of 3 runs on the day.

Classes will be A – 0-1300, B – 1301-1600, C – 1601-2000, D – 2001 and over, E – all 4WD cars.

The organisers reserve the right to combine classes if less than three entries are in a class.

TIMING

Timing is Hockey stick start and beam finish. Times will be available at control as soon as physically possible, after each run. Final results will be posted at the Prize giving function.

PRIZEGIVING

The above will be held at the PUKEKOHE CAR CLUBROOMS, Station Road, Pukekohe. All competitors are expected to attend to support the sponsors of this Event.
