**ENTRY FEE – this includes GST and Levies - \$70-00**

**Although open vehicles must have as a minimum a rollbar for protection (Rollcage Requirement Chart No. A4.4.1), any Open Vehicles that do not have adequate roll protection to prevent the likes of a fence wire from reaching the drivers body will only be accepted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.**

## **COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS**

- All drivers must hold a current Clubsport or higher licence.
- All vehicles carrying passengers shall be fitted with Rollcage, Both Front Seats, and Four, Five or Six point safety harnesses for both occupants, which must comply with Appendix Two Schedule A
- Passengers shall wear safety apparel as specified in the driver safety regulations contained in Appendix Two Schedule A.
- Drivers must be aware that all passengers must be briefed on basic event safety procedures, how to correctly wear and subsequently uncouple the safety harness.
- All passengers must sign the Passenger Indemnity and Declaration form prior to their participation.
- The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years.
- The start line will check if the passenger has signed the indemnity and declaration form before allowing the vehicle to start, if the passenger is found not to have signed said indemnity and declaration form then the vehicle will be removed from the start line and this may cause the driver to forfeit this run.
- Any passengers under 18 years of age must complete a passenger indemnity form at Documentation signed by a parent or legal guardian (not just the person taking care of the under age passenger for the day).

**DUAL DRIVERS** will be allowed at the discretion of the Organising Committee and under instruction of the Clerk of Course.

## **DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING**

The above will be held on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2012, at the venue from 8.00am to 9.30am.

## **EVENT PROGRAMME**

Drivers Briefing – 9.45am at Control at the venue.

A Reconnaissance Run/untimed practise run will be held at 10.00am this will be confirmed at Drivers Briefing.

Time, entry numbers and weather permitting – there will be a minimum of 3 runs on the day.

Classes will be A – 0-1300, B – 1301-1600, C – 1601-2000, D – 2001 and over, E – all 4WD cars.

The organisers reserve the right to combine classes if less than three entries are in a class.

## **TIMING**

Timing is Hockey stick start and beam finish. Times will be available at control as soon as physically possible, after each run. Final results will be posted at the Prize giving function.

## **PRIZEGIVING**

Prize giving will be at the venue as soon as possible following the last run of the day.
