

Rallysprints

There are events primarily for vehicles prepared for rallies. They are held on closed road venues with the course being limited to a maximum of 10 km.

The course and the way it is organised is the same as for a rally special stage and give the competitors the opportunity to both learn and practise the skills and knowledge required for rallying.

The winner of a rallysprint is the competitor (including a co-driver) who takes the least amount of time to complete the course.

Minimum Requirements

The vehicle must comply with MotorSport NZ stringent Safety Schedule A.

The drivers shall hold a licence appropriate to the event regulations which can be either ClubSport (basic club style event), National (generally involving competitors from a large number of clubs), or International (involving competitors from another country).

The driver must be a member of a MotorSport NZ member club and both the driver and passenger (co-driver) must wear an approved crash helmet^{#1} and fire retardant overalls^{#2}.

Notes:

#1 Your Club Scrutineer will check and advise if your crash helmet is acceptable.

#2 Minimum standard is cotton with close fitting cuffs.
