1. Jurisdiction

This Rallysprint will be held under the National Sporting Code of Motorsport NZ and any relevant regulations, prescriptions or specifications relating thereto. This event is a Clubsport event and is open to members of Motorsport NZ affiliated clubs.

3. The Event

The event will be held on Sunday March 14th, 2010, at Ponganui Road, Waimarama, with a gravel surface. The course consists of one 10 km run with approximately 18km of touring. **In the event of wet weather, listen to 1ZB cancellation service.**

4. Entries

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and will be accepted up till 5pm Monday, 8th March. **No entries will be accepted on the day.** A maximum of 45 cars will be accepted. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or decline any entry without explanation. Entry fee is \$160.00. This includes GST and levies.

All drivers details **must** be completed on the entry form and passenger details if possible.

5. Competitor Requirements

All drivers must hold a Clubsport or higher licence. Drivers are responsible for all passengers to sign the indemnity form at the start line. If you are carrying a passenger under the age of 18 they must have signed authority from a parent or guardian. They must also sign an underage indemnity form at the Rallysprint Headquarters.

6. Documentation and Audit Scrutineering

Documentation and Scrutineering will be held at the venue, Waimarama Hall, on the day of the event between 8.30am - 9.15am.

Should you be late for Documentation and Scrutineering on the day you will be refused entry and no refund will be made. **Your vehicle must be warranted and registered as you will be travelling on public roads. Failure to adhere to this will result in your exclusion from the event.**

7. Event Programme

- a. Driver's Briefing -9.15am at the hall at the venue.
A roll call will be held and any driver not attending will be deemed a non-starter. Be ready to race which means your car must be ready and the occupants must be wearing safety apparel.
- b. Familiarisation Run - after the completion of driver's briefing, all competitors must travel the course under the supervision of the Clerk of the Course.
- c. Time permitted all competitors will have four timed runs.
- d. We are running the event under rally conditions so you will be handed a start time at the end of each run for your following run, which means you must start in strict numerical order.
- e. If you are unable to start at your designated time during the day (for any reason) you must see Frances Jamieson at Headquarters.
- f. You will also need to fill in the 'Withdrawal Form' if you withdraw from the day and hand the form to Frances Jamieson at Headquarters.
- g. The fastest two cars in each class will have a fifth run to determine the class winner.
- h. Classes will be 0-1300, 1301-1600, 1601-2000, 2001-and over and all 4wd.
- i. The organisers reserve the right to combine classes if less than three entries are received in a class.

8. Timing

Will be rally timing with cars running at one minute intervals. There will be a ten second time penalty incurred for a jump start. Times will be available at the hall service area after each run. Final results will be posted at the after function, at the hall. **No speeding on touring, the organisers have allowed plenty of time for touring, please use extreme caution.**

9. General

- a. All servicing must be done in the designated area at the hall.
- b. No dogs or alcohol allowed at the venue.
- c. Please collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good motorsport public relations.
- d. Any driver withdrawing from the event must notify personal at any control or face exclusion from the results.
- e. All drivers will be liable for any damage that they may cause to private property, especially if you have damaged a fence. Failure to do so will incur further expense.
- f. A prize-giving will be held at the hall after the event - attendance is compulsory for all prize winners.
- g. Local community groups will be providing food, drinks, dinner and bar at the prize-giving on the day - please indicate at the bottom of your entry form if you and your team will be attending and number of people, as this is to assist.
