

Supplementary Regulations for Pukekohe Car Club Inc. **Summer Autocross 2010**

This Series will be held under the National Sporting Code of Motorsport NZ and Pukekohe Car Club Inc and any relevant regulations, prescriptions or specification relating thereto. This event is a Clubsport event and open to all MSNZ affiliated clubs.

Venues – as published on PCC website

Vehicle Requirements

All vehicles shall as a minimum be to a warrantable standard and will be subject to scrutineering as per MSNZ regulations and tyre regulations. The Clerk of Course has discretionary powers as to the type of vehicle deemed suitable for the venue.

Competitors

All drivers shall hold a current club membership of a Member or Associate Member Club. All competitors are required to produce their Club Membership Card at documentation. Any competitor under the age of 18 **without** a Clubsport Licence must complete an Under Age Indemnity form signed by a parent or guardian.

All competitors must wear 100% cotton overalls and a helmet which meet the MSNZ Standards. Competitors must also wear closed in shoes and socks – i.e. no jandals or bare feet.

All competitors will be liable for any damage and or associated costs they incur.

Double entries will be accepted for the same or different vehicles on the day.

PLEASE NOTE – Only one entry will count for points and must be nominated at Documentation. All timed runs for the nominated entry, must be completed before the second entry runs are taken.

Passengers in Vehicles

No passengers are allowed in vehicles competing unless the vehicle has a MANZ approved roll cage and the Clerk of Course has given permission to carry a passenger. Passengers must also have suitable clothing as in the description outlined above and sign passenger indemnity form.

Conduct of Meeting

Prior to competition the Clerk of the Course will hold a Drivers Briefing outlining the number of attempts, starting and finishing requirements, timing, penalties and determination of the results.

Everyone is expected to help with the clean up of the venue.

Competitors are also expected to help with marshalling and timing of the event.

All competitors are reminded to take away all their rubbish and that the consumption of alcohol by any competitor or spectator at the venue will result in immediate exclusion from the venue.

No animals allowed at the venue.

Results will be available as quickly as humanely possible following the event at the Pukekohe Car Clubrooms, Station Road, Pukekohe.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse or decline entry without explanation.

Refunds will be at the discretion of the organising committee.

Cold Drinks will be available during a lunch break.
