Competitor Requirements

All drivers must hold a Clubsport or higher licence. Drivers are responsible for all passengers to sign the indemnity form at the Start Line prior to competing and advise passengers of safety procedures. If you are carrying a passenger under the age of 18 they must fill in an Underage Indemnity Form, authorized and signed by a parent or legal guardian available at the Headquarters(Hall).

Note – This is a Rallysprint and all competing vehicles require passengers and homologated roll cages/first aid kits/tow ropes and safety triangles as per MSNZ rules and regulations.

Dual Drivers will be allowed at the discretion of the Organising Committee and under instruction of the Clerk of Course.

Please check all licences and scrutineering documents - make sure they are current.

Documentation and Audit Scrutineering

The above will be held on the day between the hours of 8.00am to 9.15am at the Awhitu Hall.

Should you be late for Documentation and Scrutineering on the day you will be refused entry with no refund being made.

All vehicles must display a current G registration and warrant of fitness.

Event Programme

Documentation and Scrutineering 8.00am to 9.15am

Drivers Briefing - 9.30am at the hall.

A roll call will be held and any driver not attending will be deemed a non-starter. Be ready to race at roll call which means your car must be ready and the occupants must be wearing safety apparel.

Familiarisation Run - after completion of Drivers Briefing all competitors must travel the course under the supervision of the Clerk of Course or their appointed Deputy.

Time permitting all competitors will have four timed runs. The fastest 2 cars in each class will have a fifth run to determine the class and overall winner.

Classes will be A/0-1300cc, B/1301-1600cc, C/1601-2000cc, D/2000 and over, E/all 4WD. The organisers reserve the right to combine classes if less than three entries are received in a class.

Timing

Will be by light start and beam finish. Times will be available at the hall as soon as physically possible after each timed run. Final results will be posted at the after event function at the hall. Jump starts will incur a 10 second penalty judge of fact will be the starter.

General

All servicing must be done in the designated areas.

No dogs allowed at the venue AND PLEASE KEEP ALL CHILDREN UNDER CONTROL. Please collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good Motorsport public relations.

Any driver withdrawing from the event must notify Administration at the Headquarters or face exclusion from the results.

Refunds will be at the organisers discretion.

All drivers will be liable for any damage that they may cause to private property.

A prize giving will be held at the hall after the event - attendance is compulsory for all competitors.

FRENZ FOR FOOD will be supplying food and drink at the hall throughout the day.
