NOTES ON COMPETITION LICENCE APPLICATION FORM

1. All applications must be signed and accompanied by the appropriate fees.
2. **Club Endorsement** - All applications must be endorsed by a Club Official or accompanied by proof of current Club membership.
3. **Date of Birth (to be used as identification)** - All applicants who are under the age of 18 years at the time of first application must ensure the MotorSport New Zealand (Inc) Indemnity Form A001A is completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian. Copies of the Indemnity Form are available from the MotorSport Office or your club.
4. **Citizenship** - Applicants born overseas are required by the FIA to obtain a clearance from the Motorsport authority of their country of origin. This clearance is required regardless of whether or not the applicant has previously competed in any form of motor sports.
5. **Expiry of Licence:**

National and ClubSport Grades

- (a) New Applications: Licence is issued for 12 months from date of issue.
- (b) Renewals: Licence is renewed for 12 months from expiry month of last held licence.

International - All International Grade Licences expire on 31 December each year.

6. **Priority Fee** - For less than three day standard turn around service - 50% of relevant licence fee in addition to licence fee. This extra fee will cover courier costs, please ensure you supply a physical address for courier delivery.
7. **Upgrade Fee** - When upgrading to a higher licence grade, if you hold a current MotorSport New Zealand licence already, you are required to pay the difference between the two licence fees (ie. Fee for new licence grade less fee paid for current licence = upgrade fee).

The expiry date of the upgraded licence remains unchanged so if the licence you hold has expired, you are required to pay the total fee.

8. **Medical Requirements:**

NOTE: *New Zealand Drivers wishing to compete in Australia on their National Licence under the Trans Tasman Agreement must note that an International Medical Card (A003) is a mandatory requirement.*

For National Grades - all competitors must, as a prerequisite to the issue of a National Race or Rally Grade licence, complete form A003a and return to MotorSport New Zealand. The fee for this has been incorporated into the licence cost.

For International Grades - all competitors must, as a prerequisite to the use of an International Race or Rally Grade licence, complete form A003 and return directly to the MotorSport New Zealand Medical Adviser, Dr Bruce Stewart.

9. **Licence Examinations for National Grades:**

In order to qualify for a National Race or Rally Grade licence you must first obtain a pass result in the applicable licence examination. Please refer MotorSport Manual or MotorSport New Zealand Administration office for a list of Licence Examiners and their contacts.
