The events will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION

3.1. The Events will be:

Day 1 – Kemp Road, Sealed Event.

Approximately 3.4km of tarmac road.
HQ – Parking around Awhitu Hall.

Preferred Competitor access: No driving through Kemp Road to HQ to protect marshals setting up.

- Travel to Waiuku township
- Turn right onto King Street, go through 2 roundabouts 1.5km, continue approximately 30kms on Awhitu Road
- Turn left to stay on Awhitu Road
- Continue onto Awhitu Central Road
- Pits are just past Kemp Road at the Awhitu Hall

Day 2 – Murray Road, Gravel Event.

Approximately 1.8km of gravel road.
HQ – Paddocks.

Preferred Competitor access: No driving through Murray Road to pits to protect marshals setting up.

From State Highway No. 1

- Travel to Mercer
- Turn onto Koheroa Road
- Turn left onto Mercer Ferry Road and head approximately 7.2kms
- Slight right onto Murray Road
- Pits are located on the left in the paddocks just before the road changes to gravel

3.2. Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

- (A) 0 - 1300cc
- (B) 1301 - 1600cc
- (C) 1601 - 2000cc
- (D) 2001 and over
- (E) All 4WD Cars

4. ENTRIES

4.1. Entries should be made through the Motorsport Online system possum.motorsport.org.nz. Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received in full.

Alternatively, entries can also be submitted manually in “hard copy” form or via email to secretary@pukekohecarclub.co.nz. All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all details, and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code.

4.2. Opening and Closing Dates: Entries open with the publication of these regulations and entries will be allowed on the day up until 9.00am but a maximum field of 70 cars will be accepted in order of receipt with preference being given to competitors competing in both days.

4.4. Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 70. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

5.1. License Requirements:

- a) All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition License and current membership with a member club.
- b) If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required.
- c) All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.
- d) Passengers may be carried in vehicles complying with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, of the current MSNZ Manual and must sign the passenger indemnity form at the start line.
- e) The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed “Clubsport Event Under Age Indemnity and Consent Form” (MSNZ form CS010) or a MSNZ competition **5.2.** license stamped “Authorised Minor”. Form CS010 can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event but must be signed by the legal guardian.

DUAL DRIVERS will be allowed at the discretion of the Organising Committee and under instruction of the Clerk of Course. **DUAL ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED BUT WILL NOT FEATURE IN THE RESULTS.**

5.2. Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In Particular:

- (a) The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- (b) Appendix Five Schedule C

5.3 All competitors must wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1. Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

6.2 All cars must have a homologated safety rollcage compliant with Schedule A of the Current Motorsport Manual.

6.3 All cars must carry a tow rope

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

7.1. Documentation and Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Saturday Documentation/Scrutineering will be located at the Awhitu Hall between 8:00am - 9:00am. Sundays Documentation/Scrutineering will be located in the paddock off Murray Road between 8:00am - 9:00am.

7.2. Drivers Briefing: Drivers Briefing – 9.30am at Control at each venue. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.

A Reconnaissance run will be held at 10:00am, this will be confirmed at Drivers Briefing.
Practice run and subsequent runs immediately following drivers briefing.
Cars to run in numerical order.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS

8.1. Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 35 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

In the event of cancellation see the PCC website www.pukekohecarclub.co.nz, or Pukekohe Car Club Facebook Page or ring the organisers.

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1. Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1. Timing is Rally start and beam finish. Times will be available at control as soon as physically possible after each run.

10.2 In the event of timing equipment failure, or as a result of instruction from the Clerk of the Course, a competitor will be allowed a re-run. Re runs will not be allowed if the timing gear is displaced or damaged by the competitor.

10.3. Reconnaissance or practice of the course is prohibited prior to the event.

10.4. Passengers: May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.

10.5. Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

10.6. Food and drinks will be available at each venue.

10.7. All servicing must be done in the designated areas. Ground sheets to be used.

10.8. All drivers will be liable for any damage that they cause to private or public property.

10.9. Please collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good Motorsport public relations.

10.10. Refunds will be at the organiser's discretion. No refunds will be considered after the start of the reconnaissance run.

10.11. Any driver withdrawing from the event must notify Clerk of Course or face exclusion from the results.

10.12. Strictly **No** animals are allowed at these venues.

Results & Prizegiving: Final results will be posted at the end of the day at the event documentation area. Prize giving for Kemp Road on Saturday will be at the Awhitu Hall following the final run, as soon as practically possible.

Prize giving for Murray Road on Sunday will be held either in the Service Paddock or the Pukekohe Car Clubrooms located on Station Road in Pukekohe following the final run, as soon as practically possible, a notice will be put up by the results advising the location before the last run.
