Supplementary Regulations

1. JURISDICTION

This event will be held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of Motorsport New Zealand, the MSNZ Hillclimb Championship Articles and any relevant regulations prescriptions or specifications relating thereto as contained in the current NZ Motorsport Manual and amendments, these are the Supplementary Regulations and Written Briefing.

3. The permit is for a Clubsport Advanced Hillclimb.

4. VENUE

The event is situated on Waikaretu-Wairamarama Road, Glen Murray.

Saturday is approximately 3.4km of tarmac with a tour back through stage. Sunday is approximately 2.7km of gravel with a tour back through stage.

Saturday Event HQ and Service Park:

The primary service park will be situated in a paddock just before 401 Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road. The entrance gate will be signposted and is visible on approach.

- Travel to Tuakau township, continue on River Road then turn off at Tuakau Bridge-Port Waikato Road.
- Travel around 25kms until you get to Port Waikato then continue on to Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road. Travel approx 7kms until you get to the woolsheds and turn right into pits.

Sunday Event HQ and Service Park:

The primary service park will be situated in a paddock located by the start line on Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road. Proceed past Limestone Downs down through the stage, the entrance gate will be signposted and is visible on approach.

- Travel to Tuakau township, continue on River Road then turn off at Tuakau Bridge-Port Waikato Road.
- Travel around 25kms until you get to Port Waikato then continue on to Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road.
- Travel approx. 14kms, go past Limestone Downs, follow the road through the stage and the pits and service park will be signposted.
- Please use a ground sheet when servicing your car

In the event of cancellation due to inclement weather, or any other reason, information will be available via the Pukekohe Car Club website (www.pukekohecarclub.co.nz), the Pukekohe Car Club Facebook page, or direct from the organising committee.

5. ENTRIES

Entries must be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://online.motorsport.org.nz>).

Email entries will also be accepted to secretary@pukekohecarclub.co.nz

Entries shall be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code. Acceptance of entry will be emailed out upon receipt of payment so please ensure a valid email address is provided.

No Late Entry Fee, entries for non-Championship competitors will be accepted on the day of the event up to 9:00am.

Number of Starters:

The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 25 entries are received at normal closing date. The maximum number of starters will be 50. Priority will be given to MSNZ Goldstar Championship competitors. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

Dual drivers will be allowed. Please indicate who you are dual driving with when you send in your entry form.

6. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A of the Current Motorsport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations. Roll Cages are mandatory.

Classes:

Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

(A) 0 - 1300cc

(B) 1301 - 1600cc

(C) 1601 - 2000cc

(D) 2001 and over

(E) 4WD

Organisers reserve the right to combine classes if less than three entries are in a class.

GOLD STAR CHAMPIONSHIP - To be eligible for point's competitors must comply with the following requirements from 2019/2020 MSNZ Hillclimb Championship articles.

USE OF SAME CAR: You must use the same car for each round - Article 2.1 (c)

ROLL CAGES: Roll Cages are mandatory - Article 2.1 (a)

PACE NOTES: The use of "Pace Notes" or similar navigation assistance is strictly prohibited - Article 10.1

PASSENGER: - "NO Driver is permitted to be a passenger in any competing car....." - Article 10.3.

7. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material.

Documentation and safety audits will be held at the event Headquarters between 8:00am and 9:00am on Saturday 15th February and Sunday 16th February.

Any vehicles that have not been audited in the last three events or were last audited more than six months ago must be audited by the event scrutineers. Any vehicles carrying passengers will be subject

to an audit. To help the event run on time please try and present all vehicles for safety auditing prior to 8:30am. Vehicles will be scrutineered to Schedule A.

All cars must have a homologated safety rollcage compliant with Schedule A of the current Motorsport Manual.

All competitors and passengers shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A. Please be aware of the new requirements that came into effect on the 1st April 2018.

8. EVENT PROGRAMME

- Documentation and scrutineering from 8:00am – 9:00am.
- Drivers Briefing – 9.30am at the event HQ. Drivers briefing is compulsory, a roll call will be held and any driver not in attendance will be deemed a non-starter. Be ready to race – this means your car must be ready and the occupants must be wearing safety apparel.
- All competitors must travel the course under the supervision of the Clerk of the Course or nominated official. There will be a convoy run immediately following the briefing. This will be followed by one timed practice run then three official runs. If time permits there may be additional unofficial runs.
- Drivers to run in numerical order.
- Dual drivers will be seeded at the discretion of the organisers.

9. RECONAISSANCE

No pre-event reconnaissance or practice is permitted. Any competitors to be found in breach of this will be excluded from entering the event and face penalties as per schedule P, A3R.10.

10. TIMING

- Timing is Rally start and beam finish. Times will be available at control as soon as possible after each run. Final results will be posted at the Headquarters in the service park.
- Jump starts: Appendix One Schedule P – Penalties, Penalty A3R.11 will apply. Judge of fact (Jumped Start) will be any of the start officials of this event.

11. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

Knowledge and Understandings:

In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. Particularly,
(a) The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitor's obligations, and
(b) Appendix Five Schedule C

- All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition License. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required. In addition, all drivers shall hold a valid civil drives license, and Club Membership of a Motorsport NZ affiliated Club.
- All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.
- Drivers must be aware that all passengers must be briefed on basic event safety procedures. All passengers must sign the passenger indemnity and declaration form prior to their participation.

The start line will check if the passenger has signed the indemnity and declaration form before allowing the vehicle to start.

- Passengers under the age of 16 are not permitted unless they hold a Motorsport NZ authorized minors license, and between 12 and 16 and present either a valid Junior Competition License or an underage indemnity form signed by a parent or guardian.
- Any competitor who causes damage to Public Property, Pukekohe Car Clubs, or their Sponsor's Property will be billed for the damage up to the excess of the Public Liability Insurance policy in the name of Motorsport New Zealand Inc. (Note: current policy excess is \$3,500)

DUAL DRIVERS will be allowed at the discretion of the Organising Committee and under instruction of the Clerk of Course.

DUAL ENTRIES (One Competitor entering twice) WILL BE ALLOWED BUT WILL NOT FEATURE IN THE RESULTS

12. ACCOMODATION

Accommodation is available at the venue on Saturday 15th February. Woolshed shearer's quarters, cost \$40.00. Please email secretary@pukekohecarclub.co.nz for enquiries.

13. PRIZE GIVING/FINAL RESULTS

Prize giving will be held in the woolshed opposite the service park on Saturday and in the paddock at the pits on Sunday as soon as possible after the event.

Provisional results will be posted during the day at the event HQ.

Final Provisional results will be posted as soon as possible after the last run. Results will be declared final 30 minutes after posting final provisional results.

14. GENERAL

- Refunds will be at the organiser's discretion. No refunds will be considered after the start of the reconnaissance run.
- Any driver withdrawing from the event must notify Clerk of Course or face exclusion from the results.
- Passengers may be changed in between runs, passenger indemnity forms must be signed.
- Competitors and their support crews must not consume or display any alcohol or drugs during the event. Failure to adhere to this will result in exclusion from the event.
- Drinks will be available at the venue.
- NO animals are allowed at this venue. This is a working farm and we request that you respect this. Please ensure any children are well supervised.
- Please collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good Motorsport public relations.
