





SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a ClubSport Basic Autocross Event, promoted by the Pukekohe Car Club being held at Mt Smart Stadium Supertop Carpark, Maurice Road, Penrose, Auckland on Saturday June 19th 2021.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the Motor Sport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.





3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

3.1 The event will be cleared signed upon entry, entry will be via the Main Entrance of the Stadium off Maurice Road, Penrose. Follow coned off area down drive to event pits.







3.2 Event HQ and Service Park:

The primary service park will be situated in the Mt Smart Supertop carpark. The entrance gate will be signposted and visible on approach, take extra care upon approach with speed reduced and parking strictly within signed area.

- Please use a ground sheet when servicing your vehicle
- Pick up all your rubbish
- Toilets will be available
- **3.3 Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:
 - (1) Class A 0 1300cc
 - (2) Class B 1301 1600cc
 - (3) Class C 1601 2000cc
 - (4) Class D 2001 Over
 - (5) Class E 4WD

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 Entries will be submitted manually in 'hard copy' form or on the Motorsport NZ Online system MotorSport New Zealand. Entry forms will be available on the website www.pukekohecarclub.co.nz and provided on the day. All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all detail, and accompanied by the appropriate fees. DUAL DRIVERS will be allowed.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.



4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close on Saturday 19th June 2021 at 12:00pm.

4.3 Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 50.

5. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- 5.1 Documentation: Will take place at the Event Control from 8:00am to 9:00am.
- **5.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection:** Autocross scrutineering will take place in the pits area from 8:00am to 9:00am. Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.
- **5.3 Drivers' Briefing:** Will be held at the Event Control area at 9:30am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and SAFETY:

5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold a current club membership of a Member club, except for new entrants to motorsport, who may compete in two (2) Basic Status Events before being required to join a club. If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Requirements & Safety:

Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. Particularly,

(a) The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitor's obligations, and (b) Appendix Five Schedule C

- All Autocross competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A
- All drivers shall hold a valid civil driver's license
- Sighting a waving red flag means STOP IMMEDIATELY
- Any competitor who causes damage to Public Property, Pukekohe Car Clubs, or their Sponsor's Property will be billed for the damage up to the excess of the Public Liability Insurance policy in the name of Motorsport New Zealand Inc. (Note: current policy excess is \$3,500)
- **5.3** For the Autocross event, competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current Motor Sport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

7. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

7.1 The event will run regardless of number of starters on the day. In the event of cancellation due to inclement weather, or any other reason, information will be available via the Pukekohe Car Club website <u>www.pukekohecarclub.co.nz</u> the Pukekohe Car Club Facebook page, or direct from the organising committee.

8. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

8.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

9. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Passengers may be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2
- Ground sheets must be used
- All rubbish must be cleared and the venue must be kept clean and clear of rubbish throughout the duration of the event
- No animals permitted at the venue

- Please ensure any children are well supervised
- Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
- Food & drinks will be available at the venue. These may be provided by the Club, please support them
- All servicing must be done in the designated areas, ground sheets to be used
- All drivers will be liable for any damage that they cause to private or public property. Excess on the Motorsport NZ Insurance is \$3,500, payable by the competitor
- Please collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good Motorsport public relations
- Refunds will be at the organiser's discretion. No refunds will be considered after the start of the event
- Competitors queries should be directed to the event organisers
- Reconnaissance or practice of the course is prohibited prior to the event
