

- 3.1** The events will be as follows: Saturday - Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road, Port Waikato. This is a challenging Tarmac event approximately 3.4km in length with a combination of tight and twisty and faster flowing sections. Sunday – Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road, Limestone Downs, a gravel favourite of many. 4.2km in length another combination of faster flowing sections along with tight and twisty sections as well.

Saturday's Event HQ & Service Park will be situated in a paddock just before 401 Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road.

Sunday's Event HQ will be in the Wool Shed at Limestone Downs, veer right into Limestone Downs off Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road, travel a few hundred meters to the end of the road. Servicing will be in a paddock close to the finish. Both will be clearly marked.

- 3.2** **Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

- (A) 0 – 1300cc
- (B) 1301 – 1600cc
- (C) 1601 – 2000cc
- (D) 2001 and over
- (E) 4WD
- (G) Cross Cars

4. ENTRIES:

- 4.1** Entries should be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://possum.motorsport.org.nz>). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Alternatively, entries may be submitted manually via email secretary@pukekohecarclub.co.nz. All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all detail, and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Entries will be accepted on the day of the event, up till 9.00am on each day. There will be no late entry fee incurred.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 **Opening and Closing Dates:**

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 9.00am on the day of the event.

- 4.4** **Number of Starters:** The maximum number of starters will be 50 with preference given to those that have paid prior to the event. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 **Licence Requirements:**

All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition Licence and current membership with a member club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.

5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

5.4 Fuel Handling: Competitors are reminded about the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. The full details of this Code is found here: <http://motorsport.org.nz/resources/safety-training/code-practice-motorsport-fuel>

5.5 There will be a convoy run directly following drivers briefing.

5.6 Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED, the residents have been instructed to inform the event organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this your entry will NOT be accepted.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

6.2 Rollcage: All cars must have a homologated safety rollcage compliant with Schedule A of the current Motorsport Manual.

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

7.1 Documentation: Will take place at the venues commencing at 8:00am and concluding at 9:00am

7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Will take place at the venue commencing at 8.00am and concluding at 9.00am. Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.

7.3 Drivers' Briefing: This will be held at the woolsheds commencing at 9:30am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

8.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers reserve the right to postpone or cancel the event.

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1 Passengers: May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.

10.2 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

10.3 Strictly no dogs allowed.

10.4 Prizegiving: Will be held in the woolshed opposite the service park on Saturday and in the Woolshed at Limestone Downs on the Sunday as soon as possible after the event.

10.5 Accommodation: Accommodation is available at the venue on Saturday 12th November at the Limestone Downs Accommodation Quarters, cost \$50.00 and the Woolshed Shearer's quarters, cost \$30.00 per person, bedding/linen will be required. Directions from Tuakau

- Travel to Tuakau township, continue on River Road then turn off at Tuakau Bridge-Port Waikato Road.
- Travel around 25kms until you get to Port Waikato then continue on to Port Waikato- Waikaretu Road. Travel approx 7kms until you get to the woolsheds and turn right into pits.

Directions from Huntly

- Cross the bridge at Huntly and travel along Heatherington Road, pass through Rotongaro and Ruawaro and head onto Naike on Hwy 22.
- Pass Thundercross Valley Dirt Bike Park, then turn left onto Waikaretu Valley Road. Turn right onto Waikaretu-Wairamarama Road, travel past Bothwell Loop Road onto Wairamarama Onewhero Road.
- Turn left onto Baker Road, at end turn right onto Port Waikato Waikaretu Road. Travel approx 12.5kms until you get to the woolsheds and turn left into pits.

Directions from Tuakau

- Travel to Tuakau township, continue on River Road then turn off at Tuakau Bridge-Port Waikato Road.
- Travel around 25kms until you get to Port Waikato then continue on to Port Waikato- Waikaretu Road. Travel approx 14kms, turn right onto Limestone Downs, follow the road to the end where you will see the woolshed. Documentation/Scrutineering in the woolshed & Trailer parking will be in the paddock.
- No cars are to be serviced at the woolsheds, servicing is in the designated paddock at the end of the event and will be clearly marked.

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- Pass Thundercross Valley Dirt Bike Park, then turn left onto Waikaretu Valley Road. Turn right onto Waikaretu-Wairamarama Road, travel past Bothwell Loop Road onto Wairamarama Onewhero Road.
- Turn left onto Baker Road, at end turn right onto Port Waikato Waikaretu Road. Travel approx 4.5kms, turn left into Limestone Downs, follow the road to the end where you will see the woolshed. Documentation/Scrutineering in the woolshed & Trailer parking will be in the paddock.
- No cars are to be serviced at the woolsheds, servicing is in the designated paddock at the end of the event and will be clearly marked.
