STANDARD SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE

1. JURISDICTION

These events are Clubsport Advanced Events, promoted by the Pukekohe Car Club. This Gravel Hillclimb is being held at Murray Road, Pukekawa.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

- **3.1** Murray Road is approximately 2.0km of gravel road. Initially quite steep and flowing with some tighter more technical corners towards the end finishing with a 90 degree right hand corner.
- **3.2 Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:
 - (A) 0 1300cc
 - **(B)** 1301 1600cc
 - (C) 1601 2000cc
 - (D) 2001 and over
 - (E) 4WD
 - (G) Cross Cars

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 Entries are preferred through the MotorSport Online system (<u>https:/possum.motorsport.org.nz</u>).

Emailed entries will be accepted on the correct entry form - secretary@pukekohecarclub.co.nz

Entries will be accepted on the day of the event, up till 9.00am on the day. There will be no late entry fee incurred.

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 9.00am on the day of the event.

4.4 Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 55 with preference given to those that have paid prior to the event. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition Licence and current membership with a member club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitor's obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.
- 5.3 All competitors and passengers shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.
- **5.4 Fuel Handling:** Competitors are reminded about the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. The full details of this Code is found here: <u>http://motorsport.org.nz/resources/safety-training/code-practice-motorsport-fuel</u>
- **5.5** There will be a reconnaissance run directly following drivers briefing.
- **5.6** Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED. The residents have been instructed to inform the event organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this your entry will NOT be accepted.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

- 6.2 Rollcage: All cars must have a homolgated safety rollcage compliant with Schedule A of the current Motorsport Manual.
- **6.3** Cross Cars must comply with Appendix 5, Schedule XC <u>https://www.motorsport.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/Schedule-XC-2021-Final.pdf</u>

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- 7.1 Documentation: Will take place at the venue commencing at 8:00am and concluding at 9:00am
- **7.2** Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Will take place at the venue commencing at 8.00am and concluding at 9.00am. Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.
- **7.3 Drivers' Briefing:** This will be held near documentation at the entry to the pits commencing at 9:30am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory a roll call will be taken and failure to attend may result in a penalty.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

8.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers reserve the right to postpone or cancel the event.

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Passengers: May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2
- Drivers must be aware that all passengers must be briefed on basic event safety procedures, how to correctly wear & subsequently uncouple the safety harness.
- All drivers & passengers must sign the passenger indemnity & declaration form prior to their participation, it is the driver's responsibility to ensure this is done. Drivers/Passengers will be given a stamp to confirm these forms have been filled out.
- The start line will check the driver/passenger has the required stamp before allowing the vehicle to start, if the driver or passenger is found not to have the required stamp then the vehicle will be removed from the start line & this may cause the driver to forfeit their run.
- The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "Clubsport Event Underage Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CS010) or a MSNZ competition license stamped "Authorised Minor". Form CS010 can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event. This is to be signed by a parent or legal guardian (not just the person taking care of the underage passenger for the day).
- NO animals are allowed at this venue. This is a working farm & we request that you respect this. Please ensure any children are well supervised
- All servicing must be done in the designated areas, ground sheets to be used
- All drivers will be liable for any damage that they cause to private or public property. Excess on the Motorsport NZ Insurance is \$3,500, payable by the competitor
- Please collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good Motorsport public relations
- Refunds will be at the organiser's discretion. No refunds will be considered after the start of the reconnaissance run
- Any driver withdrawing from the event must notify Clerk of Course or face exclusion from the results
- Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
- **Prizegiving**: Will be held in the pits as soon as possible after the event.

10. DIRECTIONS

Competitors must **NOT** use Murray Road as we are setting up for the day.

Competitors access from Auckland and Hamilton.

- From the motorway take the Mercer/Pukekawa off ramp.
- Cross the Waikato River.
- Travel along Mercer Ferry Road for approximately 7.2km
- Take a slight right onto Murray Road.

Competitors access from Pukekohe/Tuakau.

- Cross the Tuakau Bridge onto State Highway 22.
- Continue along State Highway 22 for approximately 6.7km
- Turn left onto Mile Bush Road after 1.9km
- Turn left into Murray Road
