STANDARD SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE

1. **JURISDICTION**

This event is a Clubsport Advanced Event, promoted by the Pukekohe Car being held Kemp Road, Awhitu

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A — Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

3.1 Kemp Road, Awhitu.

A Tarmac favourite of the late Rodney Atchinson. Aproximately 3.5 km in length. Starting downhill into some tight technical corners, opening up to a nice flowing uphill section, entering an often slippery tree covered tight section to emerge into some flowing right left combinations to the finish.

Documentation and scrutineering will be held in the service paddock at Awhitu Central Hall.

- **3.2** Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:
 - (A) 0 1300cc
 - (B) 1301 1600cc
 - (C) 1601 2000cc
 - **(D)** 2001 and over
 - (E) 4WD
 - (G) Cross Cars

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 We will accept entries on the day but entries via Motorsport NZ preferred.

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Entries will be accepted on the day of the event, up till 9.00am. There will be no late entry fee incurred.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 9.00am on the day of the event.

4.4 Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 50 with preference given to those that have paid prior to the event. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

5. **COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:**

5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition Licence and current membership with a member club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.
- 5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.
- **Fuel Handling:** Competitors are reminded about the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. The full details of this Code is found here: http://motorsport.org.nz/resources/safety-training/code-practice-motorsport-fuel
- **5.5** There will be a reconnaissance run directly following drivers briefing.

5.6 Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED. The residents have been instructed to inform the event organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this your entry will NOT be accepted.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

- All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.
- **6.2** Rollcage: All cars must have a homolgated safety rollcage compliant with Schedule A of the current Motorsport Manual.
- 6.3 Cross Cars must comply with Appendix 5, Schedule XC https://www.motorsport.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/Schedule-XC-2021-Final.pdf

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- **7.1 Documentation:** Will take place at the venues commencing at 8:00am and concluding at 9:00am in the Awhitu Central Hall
- **7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection:** Will take place at the Awhitu Central Hall commencing at 8.00am and concluding at 9.00am. Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.
- **7.3 Drivers' Briefing:** This will be held in under the veranda of the Awhitu Central Hall at 9:30am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory a roll call will be taken and failure to attend may result in a penalty.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

8.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers reserve the right to postpone or cancel the event.

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- **10.1** Passengers: May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.
- **10.2** Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
- **10.3** Strictly no dogs allowed.
- **10.4 Prizegiving**: Will be held as soon as possible after the event in the Awhitu Central Hall Bar will be open.

10. <u>Directions:</u>

From Waiuku travel along King Street for 1.1km and continue onto Awhitu Road for 21.5km. Slight left to stay on Awhitu Road (signs for Manukau Heads/Matakawau).

After another 4.2km Kemp Road will be on your left please **do not** drive through Kemp Road. We will have people setting up the event. Continue straight for 5.2km take a slight left (Straight ahead) onto Awhitu Central Road, after 4.1km turn right onto Manukau Heads Road. 450m up the road and the Hall is on the left just before the Awhitu Central Church
