#### 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Basic Event, promoted by the Pukekohe Car Club. The event will be held in a paddock on the property of 105 Barriball Road, Waiuku, provided to us by a club member.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

#### 3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

Pukekohe Car Club Motorkhana.

The Motorkhana will be held in a paddock at 105 Barriball Road, Waiuku. This is a family friendly, fun Motorkhana will be held for Motorkhana enthusiasts and for the purpose of driver training for our younger participants. The entry instructions will be clear on the day, please follow the signage upon arrival to the designated paddock area.

**Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

- (A) 0 – 1300cc
- (B) 1301 – 1600cc
- (C) 1601 – 2000cc
- (D) 2001 and over
- (E) 4WD

#### 4. ENTRIES:

Entries will be via Motorsport NZ and there will be paper forms that can be completed on the day. There will be a maximum of 50 Competitors on the day.

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received. Direct credit or cash on the day to enter.

Entries will be accepted on the day of the event, up till 12:00pm and there will be no late entry fee incurred.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

**5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:**

**Competitor Understanding:**

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C

**Fuel Handling:** Competitors are reminded about the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. The full details of this Code is found here: <http://motorsport.org.nz/resources/safety-training/code-practice-motorsport-fuel>

There will be demonstration runs on each course before competition starts. Driving coaches will be made available on the day to assist younger or novice drivers.

**6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES**

All vehicles shall as a minimum be to a warrantable standard, with a securely mounted seat, safe steering and effective brakes. No Rally Tyres allowed.

**7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION**

**Documentation:** Will take place in the paddock at the event. Documentation will start around 8:30m and will be available right up to 12:00pm on the day of the event.

**Drivers' Briefing:** This will be held in the paddock by the documentation tent commencing at 9:00am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory. One-on-one driver's briefings will be made available to competitors arriving beyond the indicated drivers briefing time.

**9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS**

Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code to document any specific changes throughout the day.

**10. GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Passengers:** May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C, Part Two, Article 6.4.

Driving coaches will be made available on the day to sit in with younger drivers or those who haven't participated in Motorkhana's before, for the purpose of teaching and proving guidance to drivers as they familiarise and navigate around the paddock courses.

The club will aim to run 2 – 3 Motorkhana courses at a time. Participants will be allowed 2 x timed runs at each course, the fastest time of each course runs will be recorded as your final course time. A maximum time will be added to those who do not finish all courses, all course times will be added together to provide you with an overall time for the day.

Results will be available at the documentation tent through the day, the results will be taken from the class and overall placings.

**Strictly No Dogs Allowed.** This is a working farm and we do not permit dogs on the property at all times.

**Prizegiving:** Will be held at the documentation tent in the paddock as soon as possible after the courses are complete.
