SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Advanced Event, promoted by the Pukekohe Car Club. This Gravel Hillclimb is being held at Murray Road, Pukekawa.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A - Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

Murray Road is approximately 2.0km of gravel road. Initially quite steep and flowing with some tighter more technical corners towards the end finishing with a 90-degree right hand corner.

Event Headquarters and Service Area:

HQ will be located at the start of the driveway at 308 Murray Road and primary service area will be situated inside the driveway on the grass areas. Please ensure a clear thoroughfare is kept in and out of the service area to allow vehicles to pass freely. The event will be signposted, and the service area will be visible on approach.

- Please use a ground sheet when servicing your vehicle
- Pick up all your rubbish
- Toilets will be available

In the event of cancellation due to inclement weather, or any other reason, information will be available via the Pukekohe Car Club website www.pukekohecarclub.co.nz and Pukekohe Car Club Facebook page, or direct from the organizing committee.

4. **ENTRIES:**

Opening and Closing:

Entries open with publication of these regulations and will be accepted up until 9.00am on the day. There will be no late entry fee incurred. Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Entry Acceptance:

Entries shall be completed online or via form on the day. To be deemed valid they must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 55 with preference given to those that have paid prior to the event. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms, competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. Particularly,

- The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitor's obligations, and
 - Appendix Five Schedule C
- All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition License. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required.
 - All competitors/passengers shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.
 - Drivers must be aware that all passengers must be briefed on basic event safety & accident procedures, and ensure they know how to correctly wear & subsequently uncouple the safety harness.
 - All drivers & passengers must sign the passenger indemnity & declaration form prior to their participation. It is the driver's responsibility to ensure this is done.
 - The start line will check the passenger has signed the indemnity & declaration form before allowing the vehicle to start. If the passenger is found not to have signed said indemnity & declaration form, then the vehicle will be removed from the start line & this may cause the driver to forfeit his run.
 - The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "Clubsport Event Underage Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CSport002c) or a MSNZ competition license stamped "Authorized Minor". Forms can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event. This is to be signed by a parent or legal guardian (not just the person taking care of the underage passenger for the day).

- Any competitor who causes damage to Public Property, (e.g. fences) Pukekohe Car Clubs, or their Sponsor's Property will be billed for the damage up to the excess of the Public Liability Insurance policy in the name of Motorsport New Zealand Inc. (Note: current policy excess is \$3,500).
- Any salvaging costs will be at the competitor's expense.
- Fuel Handling: Competitors are reminded about the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. The full details of this Code is found here: <http://motorsport.org.nz/resources/safety-training/code-practice-motorsport-fuel>.

DUAL DRIVERS will be allowed at the discretion of the Organising Committee and under instruction of the Clerk of Course.

DUAL ENTRIES will be permitted, and results will be based on the number of rounds completed in sequence.

5. **RECONNAISSANCE**

No pre-event reconnaissance or practice is permitted. Any competitors to be found in breach of this will be excluded from entering the event and face penalties as per schedule P, A3R.10.

6. **VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY**

All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A of the Current Motorsport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

All cars must have a homologated safety roll cage compliant with Schedule A of the current Motorsport Manual.

Note: as there is no touring on public roads, vehicles may compete without a current WOF and registration, however vehicles must be up to a wof standard.

Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

- (A) 0 – 1300cc
- (B) 1301 – 1600cc
- (C) 1601 – 2000cc
- (D) 2001 and over
- (E) 4WD
- (G) Cross Cars

7. **DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING**

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licenses and documents and issuing of competition numbers. Documentation and safety audits will be held at the event Headquarters at the driveway, 308 Murray Road between 8:00am and 9:00am on Saturday 19th September 2026.

Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.

Any vehicles that have not been audited in the last three events, or last audited more than six months ago, must be audited by the event scrutineers.

8. **EVENT PROGRAMME**

- A compulsory Drivers Briefing will be held at around 9:00am near the HQ. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend may result in a penalty. Be ready to race – this means your car must be ready and the occupants must be wearing safety apparel by 9:30am
- A Familiarisation Run will be held around 9:30am, all competitors must travel the course under the supervision of the Clerk of the Course or nominated official
- We will have as many runs as time permits. The final result will be the fastest time of the day, except dual entries

which will only count the fastest run in the number of completed runs in sequence.

- Car running order will be at the discretion of the organizers. Competitors to try and run in numerical order

9. **TIMING**

Timing is beam start and beam finish.

10. **OFFICIAL BULLETINS**

Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

11. **PRIZEGIVING/FINAL RESULTS**

Provisional results will be posted at HQ, after the last run of the event. Results will be declared final after 30 mins. A Prizegiving will be held at the Pukekohe Car Clubrooms on Station Road, Pukekohe. Refreshment & food will be available. Results will be posted on the Club Facebook page as soon as possible after the event.

12. **GENERAL**

- **NO animals are allowed at this venue.** This is a working farm & we request that you and any supporters respect this. Failure will result in us asking you to leave
- Please ensure children are well supervised
- All servicing must be done in the designated areas, ground sheets to be used
- Collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good Motorsport public relations
- Refunds will be at the organiser's discretion. No refunds will be considered after the start of the reconnaissance run
- Any driver withdrawing from the event must notify Clerk of Course or face exclusion from the results
- Competitors and their support crew must not consume or display any alcohol during the event. Failure to adhere to this will result in exclusion from the event

13. **ARRIVAL DIRECTIONS**

Competitors must **NOT** travel through Murray Road from Highway 22 end, upon arrival as we will be setting up the road for the day.

Access from Auckland/Hamilton

- From the motorway take the Mercer/Pukekawa off ramp
- Cross the Waikato River
- Continue along Mercer Ferry Road for approximately 7kms
- Turn right onto Murray Road
- Continue along Murray Road for approx.

1.6kms

Access from Pukekohe/Tuakau

- Cross Tuakau Bridge onto State Highway 22
- Continue approx. 6.5kms
- Turn left on Mile Bush Road
- Continue 1.8kms & turn left onto Murrays Road
- Continue along Murray Road for approx. 1.6kms
- Turn left into service area at 308 Murray Road
